A boarding experience

The student lives on campus and joins the residential programme.

Consider daily routines, supervision, room arrangements, communication and readiness.

A day programme

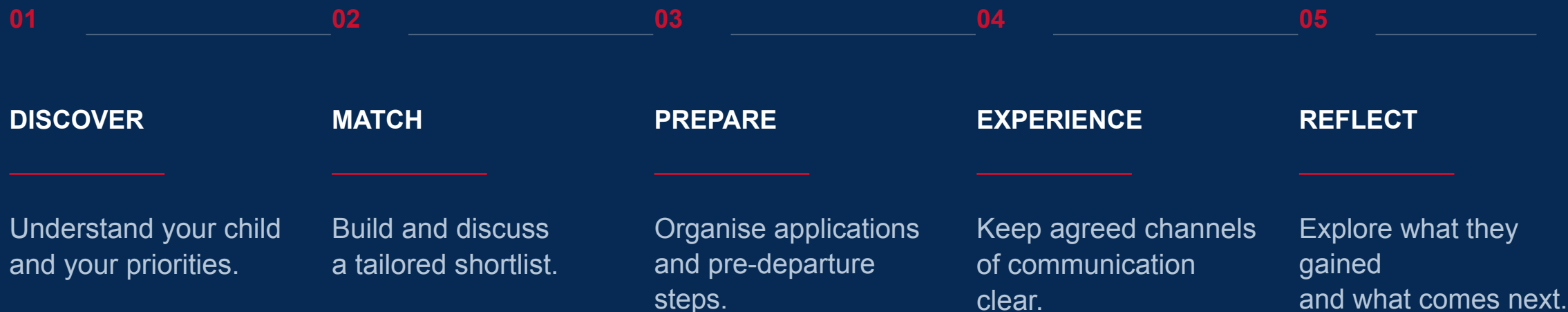
The student joins daytime activities; accommodation is planned separately.

Consider family logistics, local transport, pick-up arrangements and the full travel budget.

A first experience abroad may need a different format, pace or duration.

Fees & conditions

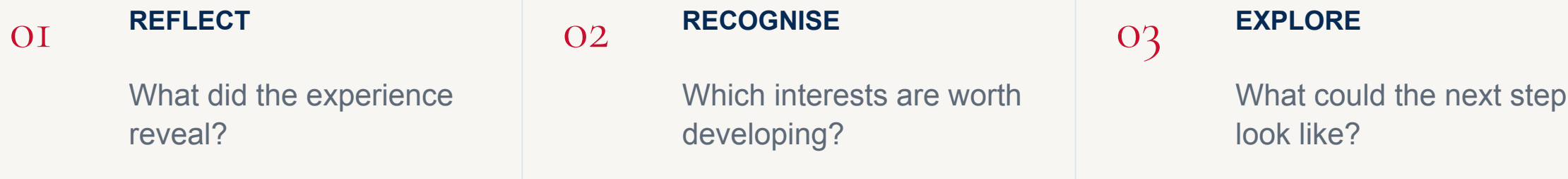
What is included, what costs extra, and what are the cancellation terms?
